Match Headline : Saint Returns and Dolt still win.

The Saint aka Mike Whibley made a rare return to Jakarta, not only to hold the Dragon's hand but also to make up the numbers for the first time in a JIFL fixture since the 2005/2006 season. After rolling back the years and being top scorer in the Penang 6's last weekend, the Saint was desperate for a start. However the Saint's pre-match routine of "ooh doesn't Nico look good, they've got a strong squad, we'll be lucky today etc" doesn't fit in with Manager Roberts winning mentality and he was duly dropped from the starting line up – much to the relief of the younger Lisa Stanfield who retained his place up front and everybody else who has seen Whibley play in defence.

With Dolt having it's strongest squad of the season available - it may have been slightly stronger and certainly heavier if Pikey Satu aka Lardy Boy had been available, but the absence of ENLAC significantly outweighed this slight negative, Do It were looking forward to a hard but successful day out.

Under Manager's orders to stay in on Friday night, Do It's players duly responded and turned up sober for once, not one of the team having the proverbial 6 beers and a couple of JWBL's prior to the game. An unfamiliar sight therefore met Bigear's Wife Donna Whyte when all 15 players turned up on time and suitably kitted out. The only surprise in the warm up being Lewis Whyte pole axing Mum with a wicked shot straight to the face resulting in a) two black eyes for Donna, and, b) Lewis not daring to go home all weekend.

With Lardy Boy taking Bigears ass licking duty role for the weekend and Bignose back from a 4 nation tour in 6 days, Dolt started with a different 11 to that which ended the German+ game comprising Erwin, James, Bigears and Bignose in defence, Fandi, Super Al, Youngears, Manager Ian and GJ in midfield with Pikey 24 partnering the younger Lisa Stansfield up front.

First Half Highlights

- Do It's forwards missing various gilt edge chances – none worse than Lisa's open net miss
- Marc opening the scoring for OT as his deceptive cross dipped under the bar whilst Erwin was sleeping
- Lisa scoring the most difficult of his chances from an excellent up and under cross from Pikey24
- The tricky conditions contributing to various stumbles and falls from the OT forwards, none worse than when a 4ft tall blade of grass managed to come to life Triffid style and trip Nico in the box – a blatant penalty that wasn't awarded by the ref, though the blade of grass was severely reprimanded at half time and removed by Gracie Fields' groundstaff. NC's comment that it was only a joke, didn't make us laugh.
- After a half that Dolt restricted OT's strikers to 2 shots the half time score was thus

- A positive team talk from Roberts resulted in new Dad Fyffe substituting Bignose, whilst Lisa left stage left and was replaced by the Saint.
- Second half was when Super Al came to life striding into the box, rounding the defender and coolly beating the OT's keeper at the near post to make it 2-1. This was shortly followed by the Saint dispossessing the OT left midfielder only for the ball to squirm left to Al who put the ball behind the defence and picked out the central run of Pikey23 who finished with a difficult half volley lob over the keeper to make it 3-1 and Pikey24.
- Dolt had two goals disallowed, one from Lewis who was "too strong" for the OT defender and one from the Saint who in rolling back the years had forgotten that the rules have changed somewhat and that forcing the ball, keeper, defender and referee into the goal Dixie Dean style is no longer tolerated.
- One outrageous pace of skill from Fandi – a dragback pirouette – which dummied the whole of the OT defence and the watching crowd in one swift movement it was that good
- A superb one handed flying save from Erwin to atone for sleeping in the first half.
- Paul Burnett replacing The Saint and being more effective
- Super Al almost rounded of a brilliant display by scoring a brilliant solo fourth, but did shortly after, as Redmist Coulthard returned and secured a yellow card with 16mins to go thus earning himself an early beer/bath combo, and

an unfortunate 15 minutes of running for Bignose and thus consequential nail biting all round.

Final Score Do It 4 – One Tree 2

A great result secured in a slightly heated game. The defence was excellent yet again – we could have played without Bigears such was performance of James in particular, again. Coupled with an all action display from midfield and MOTM Thief Pikey 24 getting in on the act again, meant that DoIt returned to top of the table with 5 games to go.

Post match activities involved 78 B52's, 20+ pitchers of beer, one plate of chips, a rare duet with Gracie Fields (Denis Clarke) and Lisa Stansfield (Mark Wagstaff), Man Utd. fans weeping in their beer, followed by various degrees of hangover Sunday morning.

All in all a great day out with the only downside being the Saint's promise to return more often.
